



'Satellite Boy' receives Special Mention at Berlin

Western Australian indigenous drama, *Satellite Boy* recently screened at the Berlin International Film Festival and has received a Special Mention from the children's and international juries in the Generation Kplus program. The feature film, from first time writer/director Catriona McKenzie and has enjoyed great success so far on the international circuit with screenings in Toronto and Abu Dhabi.

Filmed in the Kimberley and captured beautifully by cinematographer, Geoffrey Simpson, *Satellite Boy* also marks the first occasion where a film has been allowed to shoot in the magnificent Bungle Bungle range in the Kimberley.

Fellow Australian films at the festival also enjoyed great success. Winning Best Feature in the Generation Kplus program was Kim Mordaunt's debut feature, *The Rocket* and taking out the Best Short Film category in the same section was Matthew Moore's short, *The Amber Amulet*.

Satellite Boy is written and directed by Catriona McKenzie, produced David Jowsey and stars Cameron Wallaby and Joseph Pedley as well as legendary Indigenous actor David Gulpilil.
